

New Puppy List for Miniatures

- Wire crate for crate training. The size crate we use follows. We recommend the size 30.5" x 21" x 25.5" or something similar. This particular crate came from www.drsfostersmith.com

Hammertone Fold & Carry Cage

- Door-in-door allows you to care for your pet without letting him out
- Reinforced locking corners for extreme strength
- Handy, Fold & Carry design includes convenient handle
- Built-in moat on tray captures fluids and helps keep pet dry

Unique hammertone finish on a kennel that assembles in seconds! Use at home or on the road. Many problem-solving features built into this design. Positive-locking door latch improves security and ease of use. A secure tray channel prevents your dog from chewing on the plastic tray. Rubber feet keep kennel secure and prevent scratches to vinyl and wood floors. Rounded corners prevent snags. 1-1/2" bar spacing on all sizes.



- Old towels for crate until puppy is trained, then get a "real" crate bed
- Old blanket or towel to cover wire crate at night (like a birdcage)
- Urine neutralizing cleaner (we use OdoBan)
- Stainless steel water bowl and food dish (non tip)
- Pinch buckle collar with a 6 foot leash (don't forget ID tag)
- Soft slicker brush
- Kong (stuff with soft food or treat) helps with crate training and keeps them busy & Nylabone chew bones (no rawhide).
- Puppy biscuits
- Training treats (we use Charlie Bear)
- Soft chew toys (watch to make sure they don't ingest pieces)
- Fetch and interactive toys
- Make appointment with Vet for puppy wellness checkup
- Start shopping for Obedience classes
- Don't forget to puppy-proof your home. Shoes are a favorite chew
- LOTS of LOVE and PATIENCE

HOUSE TRAINING SCHEDULE FOR YOUNG PUPPIES

This schedule is just an example. During training puppy should be taken to soiling area about every hour and a half when you are home.

6:30 a.m.	Rise and walk puppy.
7:00 a.m.	Feed puppy and offer drink of water. Walk puppy, play briefly, and return to crate.
Mid a.m.	Walk puppy and keep with you 15 minutes. Return to crate.
Noon	Feed puppy second meal and offer water. Walk puppy, play briefly, and return to crate.
Mid p.m.	Offer water, walk, and return to crate.
5:00 p.m.	Feed third meal and offer water. Walk puppy, then allow to play in room with you.
7:00 p.m.	Walk puppy, return home, play, and return to crate.
Before bed	Walk puppy and put to sleep for night in crate.
